Auckland Drum Sustainability Services is committed to supplying environmentally sustainable products that meet the needs of our customers. We will work to continuously improve in this area to ensure our environmental footprint is minimised and that we meet the requirements of all stakeholders without compromising the needs of future generations.

Auckland Drum Sustainability Services works with suppliers, customers, government, industry bodies and the community to collect 'hard to recycle' packaging and extend its life via reconditioning or remanufacturing. This results in:

- Reduced net waste disposal; and
- Minimised lifecycle impacts of packaging.

Within its own operations, Auckland Drum Sustainability Services will:

- Require employees to comply with all applicable environmental laws, regulations and standards as well as Auckland Drum Sustainability Services' voluntary commitments to the community;
- Identify and manage the environmental risks within its operations and set objectives and targets to reduce them;
- Use natural resources, including energy and water, responsibly and minimise greenhouse gas emissions and other pollution impacts of reconditioning and remanufacturing processes;

- Responsibly manage and reduce waste production and disposal from our operations;
- Implement and use an environmental management system to plan, document, measure, monitor and review environmental performance; and
- Communicate this Policy and the Environmental Management System to all employees, contractors and other stakeholders as well as make this Policy available to the general public.

All employees are required to implement practices consistent with this Policy and Auckland Drum Sustainability Services' objectives, standards and guidelines for environmental management.
